PARENT ALERT LETTER, SUN VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL

The Board of Education for Union County Public Schools has set grade promotion standards in grades 9 through 12.

Promotion standards at all Union County Public Schools are as follows:

To be classified as a sophomore, a student must have passed the number of units equal to his/her maximum potential less two (2) units. One unit must be English I.

To be classified as a junior, a student must have passed the number of units equal to his/her maximum potential less three (3) units. One unit must be English II.

To be classified as a senior, a student must have passed the number of units equal to his/her maximum potential less four (4) units. One must be English III.

For more information on calculating maximum potential, please refer to page 13 of the High School Program of Studies.

School Board policy also limits the number of absences which may be accumulated if course credit is to be awarded.
