Drop Out Prevention Plan

- Administration will share information with staff from the Summer Leadership Conference related to the risk factors for dropping out of school. Individual teachers will use their homeroom list to highlight students that fall into one of these risk categories. During monthly RTI meetings, teams will discuss the academic progress of these students.
- Invite FHHS cluster Drop-out Prevention Counselor to a staff meeting for professional development.
- Establish partnerships with local churches for the Weekend Back Pack Program to provide food for children. Without proper nutrition, students can't learn to the best of their ability.
- Establish partnerships with local churches for clothing assistance for students in need. Without basic clothing, coats, shoes, students personal living needs aren't being met. This impacts their academic performance.
- Host parent curriculum nights to share ideas of how parents can help their children at home with Reading and Math.
