Classroom training at Union County Early College will be scheduled through Sun Valley High School. Check with Sun Valley High School – Driver Education Lead Teacher for exact classroom schedule.

- Additional classes may be scheduled on a school-by-school basis
 - o Each course involves 36 hours of classroom work and a minimum of 12 hours of instruction in the car (6 hours driving and 6 hours observing).

Registration Procedures:

- In order to register, each student must bring his or her birth certificate to the first class. In addition, each student from a private or home school must bring a letter verifying that he or she is currently enrolled in school.
- If the student lives in Union County, but attends school outside of the county, student still eligible to receive Driver Education instructional (classroom and behind-the-wheel) training. Students should contact school, where they would have attended, to be scheduled for Driver Education training. Or student may contact Union Academy to be scheduled for training. Union Academy will train charter, private and home school students.
- If the student lives outside of Union County, student is NOT eligible to participate in the Driver Education program (classroom and/or behind-the-wheel) training.
- Participants will be enrolled on an age-priority basis. In order to be eligible to enroll in the program, an individual must meet the following requirements:
 - o Between the ages of 14 ½ and 18 on the first day of classes.
 - o Middle School students ARE eligible to take Driver's Education as long as they are the legal age.
 - o Approved by the Principal of the high school that he or she's attending.
 - o Attending a public, private or home school within Union County.
 - o Have not previously enrolled in the program.

There is a \$45 registration fee that is due before the first day of class. Students may also contact a private company at their own expense.

Students who have dropped out of school or who have enrolled in driver education previously are not eligible for these classes.
