

# Fifth Grade Promotion 2014-2015

For some fifth graders, this will be the first time they participate in a formal event. We want to prepare our students for any situation that life presents (weddings, funerals, job interviews, etc.). Help us by speaking with your child about the behavior expectations involved with a formal event. Teachers will review expectations at promotion practice as well.

The ceremony will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m. Please make sure students arrive ahead of time (**by 6:45**).

Students will need to meet their homeroom teacher at the cafeteria tables to organize for the procession into the auditorium. Parents, you will want to find seats in the auditorium as soon as your child is with his/her teacher. The first few rows will be reserved for fifth grade students, but all others will be available for family and friends. 😊

**After the ceremony, we ask that in honor of the fifth grade classes, you remain seated until ALL fifth grade students have recessed out of the auditorium.** They will be with their teachers in the cafeteria.

Ceremonial certificates will be handed out during the event, but actual certificates will be given out at a later time.

Casual-dress attire is recommended. **No shorts or jeans.** Be mindful of footwear choices. The stage is a slick wooden walk. Girls' heeled shoes make for a loud and wobbly experience. Clothing ideas are listed below.

- Girls: Blouse, collared shirt, pants (khaki style or dress), skirt, or dress
- Boys: Polo or button down shirt, and pants (khaki style or dress)
